### vs. 1 How Firm a Foundation

leaving the principals of the doctrine of Christ -- let us go on unto perfection -- not laying again the foundation of repentance to dead work -- and of faith toward God -- show diligence-- be not slothful

(Hebrews 6: 1-12)

the wise man built his house upon the rock (Matthew 7:24-29)

after he hath laid foundation -- is not able to finish (Luke 14:25-30)

### vs. 1 Unto Jesus Have Fled

let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith (Hebrews 12:1-2)

who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us --

which hope we have as an anchor to the soul (Hebrews 6:13-20)

### vs. 2 Fear not, I am with thee

let not your heart be trouble -- I go to prepare a place (John 14:1-6)

come ye that labor and are heavy laden -- take my yoke upon you -- I a meek and lowly in heart -- you shall find rest unto your (souls) -- My yoke is easy and my burden is light

(Matthew 11:28-30)

### vs. 2 I'll strengthen thee help thee and cause thee to stand

For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

(Romans 5:1-11)

the gospel - wherein ye stand - By which also ye are saved,

(I Corinthians 15:1-4)

I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

(Philippians 4:13)

**vs. 3 rivers of sorrow shall not overflow**

godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation (II Corinthians 7:8-10)

God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that you are able (I Corinthians 10:13)

Let not your heart be troubled, ye believe in God, believe also in Me. (John 14:1-6)

the Lord shall descend - dead in Christ rise first - The we which are alive and remain - Wherefore comfort one another with these words. (I Thessalonians 4:3-18)

**vs. 4 fiery trials - grace all sufficient - the flame shall not hurt thee - I only design - Thy dross to consume and thy gold to refine**

My grace is sufficient - for my strength - perfect (II Corinthians 12:1-9)  
humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God - casting all your care upon Him; for He careth for you - God - stablish - strengthen - settle you (I Peter 5:9) faith - refined gold (I Peter 1:3-9)(Rev. 3:14-22)

**vs. 5 E'n down to old age all my people shall prove- My sovereign love**

The hoary head is a crown of glory, if it be found in the way of righteousness. (Proverbs 16:31)

marriage of Lamb - made herself ready - fine linen - clean and white - righteousness of the saints (Revelation 19:7)

**vs. 6 The soul that on Jesus hath leaned - I will not desert**

translated from the power of darkness into the kingdom of His dear Son (Colossians 1:8-13)

if we walk in the light, as He is in the light - the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin (I John 1:5-7)

be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life (Revelation 2:8-11)
